- Oliver (run away)
- Oliver (faint)
- The shopkeeper (enter) the courtroom
- Oliver (look at) the Dodger
- The judge (read) the punishment

Use the example (1) and the word bank on the right to make sentences to talk about the situations. Pay attention to the difference between the 2 preterites and irregular verbs.



Ex.: At a bookshop, the Dodger was stealing a customer's handkerchief when the shopkeeper saw him.
