Waiter

1) Job duties and tasks

- A waiter is a person who works in a restaurant or in a bar.
- You must greet customers and take their orders.
- You also have to serve food and drinks at their table.
- You must clear, clean and set tables for the customers.
- You are also required to take payment and make change.

2) Skills /competences

- To be a waiter, you need to be good with words when you talk to the customers. It means that you have to strong communication skills.
- It is also very important to be quick to react, have good reflexes and service skills.
- Then, you must be able to carry a tray full of beverages or dishes, which is not quite easy.
- You have to have knowledge about menu items and wine
- It is necessary to have food and drink service skills
- You must know about food health and safety

3) Qualities

- The main quality for this job is to be physically fit, energetic and efficient.
- A good waiter **must** move swiftly without appearing to run or rush.
- You also need to be friendly and keen with the customers. That's why if you are not very outgoing, this job is not made for you.

4) Working conditions/ salary

- Waiters work full or part-time hours, and may work evenings and weekends
- There is usually a dress code that you have to respect, depending on the company where you work.
- Waiters usually earn between minimum wage and \$19 an hour. They may also receive tips from customers, but it is up to the cafe/restaurant manager whether the tips are kept by individuals or divided equally among staff.

5) Studies / diplomas

There are no specific requirements for waiters/waitresses as training is done on the job.

6) <u>Drawbacks</u>

- Working long hours non-stop.
- Working outside may be asked.
- Being able to work well under pressure.
- It is often asked to work evenings and weekends.
- You must spend a lot of time on your feet, in environments that can be noisy and stressful.
