

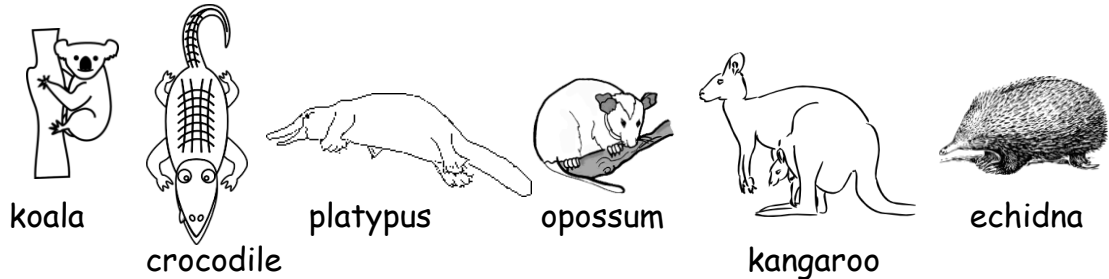
There's Nothing Like Australia!

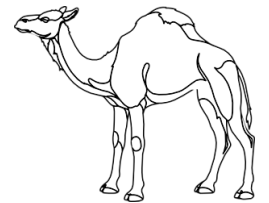

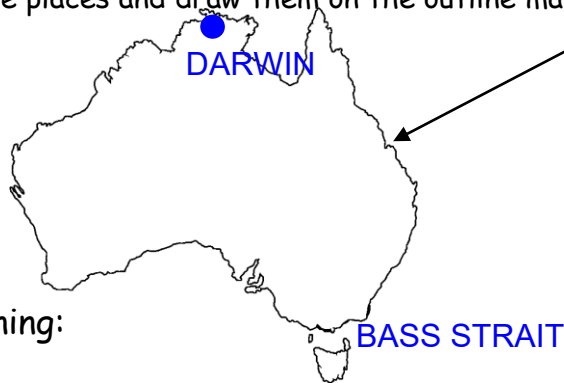
