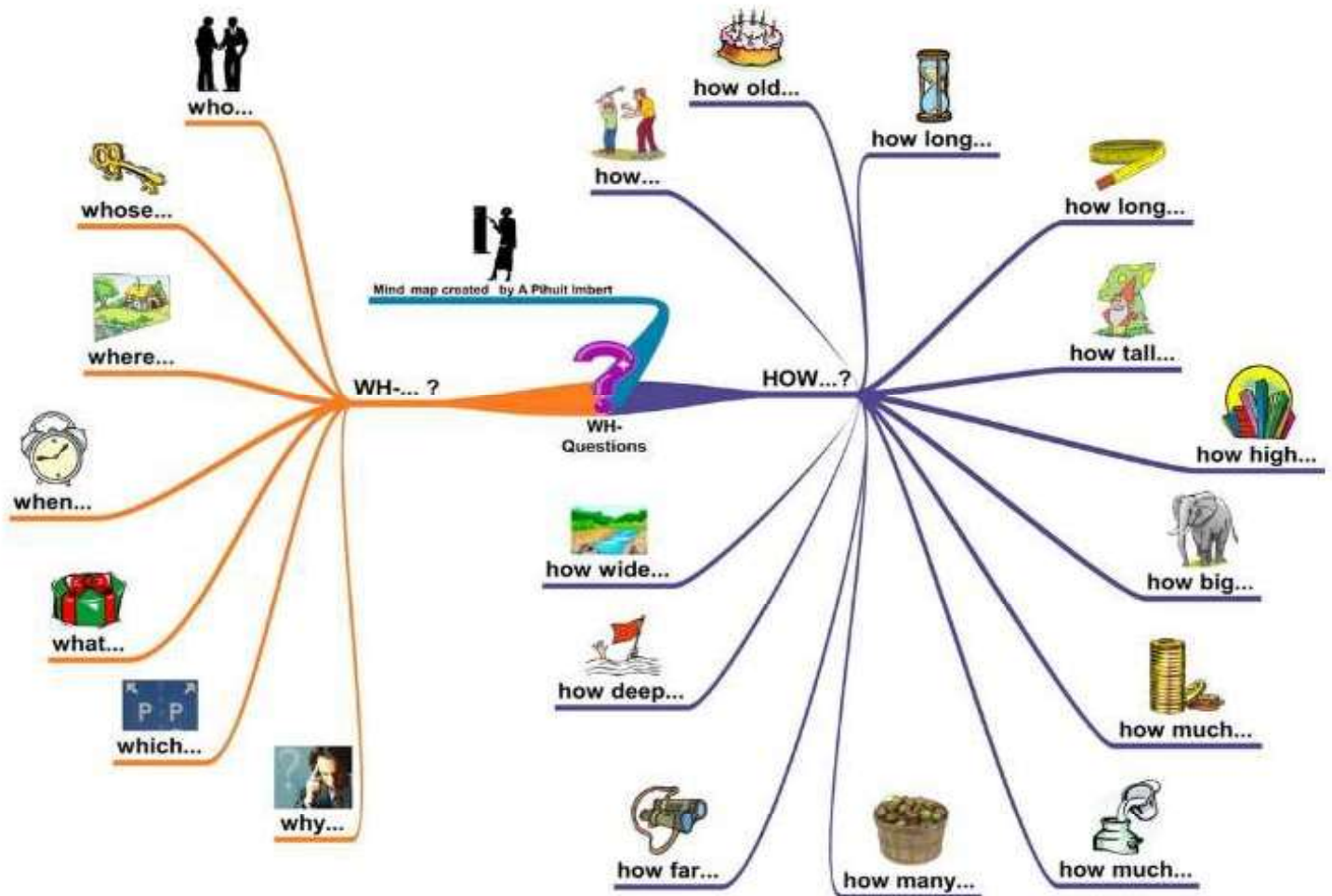


Je retiens...(Rappel) – les pronoms interrogatifs



>> Attention à l'ordre des mots dans une question. La plupart du temps, le pronom interrogatif est suivi de l'opérateur, du sujet et du verbe. **Wh + opérateur + sujet + verbe (non conjugué)**

What **did** he write ? He **wrote** drama plays. (dans la réponse, on conjugue le verbe au temps de la question)
How **did** he discover the world of drama ? He **discovered** it ...

Retrouve la question posée

- 1) He lived in England.
- 2) He met a woman called Anne Hathaway.
- 3) He went to London 3 years later.
- 4) He was 11 when he saw Queen Victoria.
- 5) He wrote plays because he loved that.

Retrouve la question en How...

- 1) He had 3 children.
- 2) London is 160km away from Stratford.
- 3) It's 10€
- 4) This building is 75 floors high !
