2/ What type of bullying was it ?

It was physical bullying.

3/ How did the victim feel ?

The victim felt scared and impressed because he said he felt "smaller and smaller"

DAY 4

4/ On Day 4, was it better or worse than the 3rd day ?

It was better than the 3rd day.

5/ Did he tell someone or did he defend himself?

He stuck up for himself so he didn't tell anyone, he defended himself.

6/ Bullies stopped insulting him. True or false ? Justify.

True. He said "they didn't call me names" so they stopped insulting him.

7/ Bullies left him out of activities. True or false? Justify.

False. He said : "they let me play their games". So they didn't leave him out of activities.

8/ He had some friends. True or false. Justify.

True. He said "we were all friends". So he was not alone.

9/ He was feeling good at school. True or false. Justify.

True and false. He didn't want to go home (it's positive) but he said "I had an OK day" so it was NOT a very good day

10/ The victim didn't trust his new friends. (trust=fair confidence). True or false?

True. he said "it wouldn't last" (cela ne durerait pas) so he thought it was not sincere.
