Exercice 1 : Traduis les phrases suivantes (aide-toi des cours !!)

9. A mon avis, il y a plein de choses à faire à New York, mais ça doit être bruyant.

To my mind/In my opinion, there are many things to do in NY, but it must be noisy.

10. Si tu aimes prendre des photos et faire du shopping, tu dois aller à Time Square. C'est impressionnant !

If you like to take pictures and go shopping, you must/have to go to Time Square. It's impressive!

Exercice 2 : Conjugue le verbe au temps qui convient. (aide-toi du poly « TENSES »)
