**usually** = habituellement/d'habitude

**sometimes** = des fois/parfois/quelques fois

**never** = jamais

**almost everyday** = Presque tous les jours

**once a week** = une fois par semaine

**twice a month** = deux fois par mois

**three times a year** = trois fois par an

**every Monday** = tous les lundis

**end up (+verb ING)** = finir par (+verbe)

**pester** = harceler/bassiner

**I have to / must** = je dois

**a bank account** = un compte bancaire

**normally** = normalement

**as well** = aussi/également

**Are you able to (+V) ?** = es-tu capable de...?

**in return** = en retour

**most of (+nom pluriel)** = la plupart de/des...

**a few (+nom pluriel)** = quelques...

**whatever** = peu importe/tout ce que

**however** = cependant
