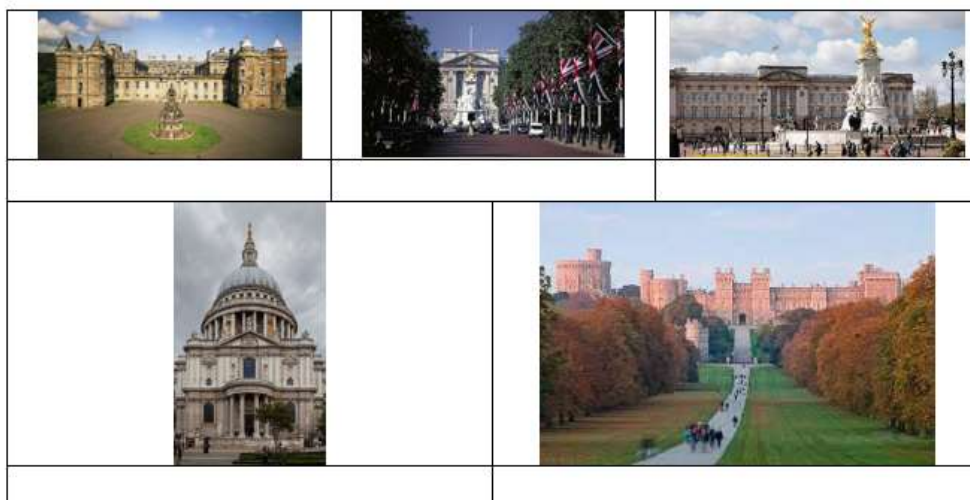
BANK HOLIDAY WEEKEND
