**Discours direct (bulle)** (direct speech) le personnage parle, souvent à la 1ere personne avec des guillemets.

**Discours indirect** (reported speech) : on rapporte ce que le personnage dit : on commence par une verbe introducteur comme « **he/she says that...** » on passe à la 3eme personne (on change les pronoms) et on retire les guillemets.
