An old and ugly woman who casts a spell on the princess because she is jealous or simply evil. She is often in conflict with everyone else but she also has some help: she often uses magic or monsters, she can create potions and curses.



A kind-hearted, helpful friend of the main characters who comes to help them solve their problems. She often uses magic or a wand and she is represented with wings. She is also smaller than humans but she can fly.

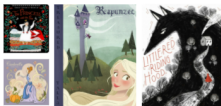

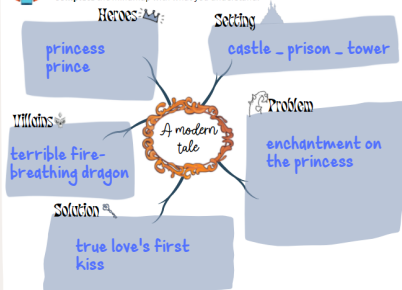
