

Scene Synopsis

Once upon a time

Howdya Like Them Apples?

We're introduced to the 'Ten Minutes of Terror', Lady Protectress and Gudishews: "NO DARK DOG! The Dark Dog is the enemy and the world outside is dangerous" Lady Protectress warns us so. Gudishews and Lady Protectress discover that Flick is gone - she's escaped prison! Lady Protectress conjures up a plan to tell the town that the Dark Dog took her. Gudishews is left to tidy up the mess and decides, actually, he will find Flick and save her!

Fishing for Confidence
