There are a lot of legends linked to him. He drove the snakes out of Ireland and used the shamrock to explain the Trinity.



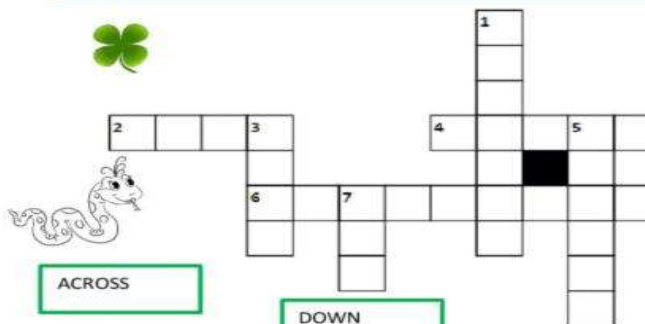
Patrick was born in Roman Britain in about 387 A.D. He was kidnapped at the age of 16 and taken to Ireland as a slave.

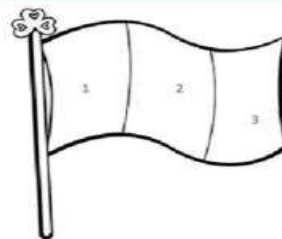
